Approximate Cost:

\$3400: Includes flights and all other costs associated with the trip such as a translator and their trip expenses, food, lodging, in country transportation, and camp supplies.

Approximate Summer 2020 Mission Trip Timeline: June 11th – June 24th

- Thursday June 11th: Depart TX
- Friday June 12th: Arrive in Kiev
- Saturday June 13th: Travel to Zaporizhia
- Sunday June 14th: Church in Ukraine
- Monday June 15th: Prepare for Camp
- Tuesday June 16th – Monday June 22nd: Camp
- Monday June 22nd to Kiev
- Tuesday June 23rd Kiev for sightseeing
- Wednesday June 24th Depart Kiev

Mandatory for Trip Participation:

- Commitment: Application Due December 1st 2019- available on the PHA website under the Mission Trips tab.
- Team Training is tentatively set for February 8th. More details to come!
- Initial Deposit to cover flight (\$1400) due February 26th (PHA will purchase flights approximately March 1st)
- Medical Forms (current vaccinations and a physical that is less than 2 years old, examples will be provided)
- A copy of your valid passport
- Completed certificate for the child protection training (no less than every 2 years)
- Total Trip Funds Due – May 15th

Due to Ukrainian Camp facility size constraints this year's team will be limited to 10 team members.

- Priority will be given to the first 10 team members to submit a completed application.
- Applicants after the first 10 will be placed on a waiting list in the order in which completed applications are submitted.
- For fairness to all team members, if you fail to attend the mandatory team training in February, your spot will be made available to the next person on the waiting list.
- For fairness to all team members, if you fail to make your initial deposit deadline your spot will be made available to the next person on the waiting list.
- If you fail to raise your needed funds, complete your child protection training or if you do not turn in all needed documents (your application, passport, medical documents) you will not be allowed to travel with the team to Ukraine.
